³⁵ And Jesus went throughout all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom and healing every disease and every affliction. ³⁶ When he saw the crowds, he had compassion for them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. ³⁷ Then he said to his disciples, “The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; ³⁸ therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest.”

REACH: Applying the truth of the Gospel to the World Around us

The goal of REACH is to equip and encourage believers at Hope Bible Church to proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ.

The process:

- REACH Sunday's - One Sunday per quarter emphasize evangelism from the pulpit. The need for, the how-to, etc.
- Encourage believers to consider three people with whom they can be praying for, compassionately pursuing, and intentional in sharing the gospel.
- Engage in two community events in the City of O'Fallon to represent Christ in simple ways.
- Emphasize evangelistic prayer.
- Organize a team of those who have the gift of evangelism or exhibit a strong desire to share their faith that can help promote and encourage people to share the gospel.

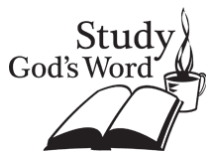
What Did You Expect?
